

Set Up & Tear Down Crew Summer Part-time contract

Must be available 2 days per week- Wednesdays & Saturdays including July 1st Canada day.

Peterborough Musicfest (PMF) is an independent non-profit, charitable organization that typically offers free- admission concerts most Wednesday and Saturday evenings during its summer season. Our stage has seen the likes of Dallas Green from City and Color, Terri Clarke, Sam Roberts, k-os, Walk Off the Earth, Tegan & Sara, Carly Rae Jepsen, Our Lady Peace, Tom Cochrane, Kiefer Sutherland, and many more. PMF is one of the largest free festivals of its kind in Canada and has an outsized impact on the local economy, generating upwards of \$4.3M in economic activity. We're proud of what we have built, and we invite qualified candidates to bring their talent and passion to our summer team.

Set up & Tear Down Crew are responsible for assisting with the stage and park setup for each concert. This position is not funded through Canada Summer Jobs (CSJ) and is open to all the applicants. Candidates must be available to work every Wednesday and Saturday from June 29 until end of August, as well as Canada Day- mornings and evenings following every show.

Key responsibilities:

- 1. Assist with loading/unloading of the production equipment.
- 2. Set up chairs, tents, fencing, backline, LED screens, signage.
- 3. Physical ability to lift and move equipment weighing up to 50lbs.
- 4. We are an outdoor festival, applicants must be comfortable working in varying weather conditions (rain or shine).

The Role:

Set up & tear down crew are responsible for setting up the VIP section which includes; bring stacks of chairs out on dollys, setting up sections, moving fencing, setting up signage and tents within the park. The Crew will be then break once everything is set up and will return towards the end of the concert to strike everything that was set up and place away back into our containers till the following concert.

Must be over the age of 14 and available to work every Wed. & Sat. from June 29 to Aug 21 as well as Canada Day, July 1st. Rain or shine. Police check required.
